(d.b.a., The Center) is one of the largest and most vibrant LGBT community centers in the nation. Functioning as the San Diego LGBT community's anchor organization, The Center is led by a 10-member board of directors, employs more than 55 paid staff and utilizes more than 1,200 community volunteers to achieve its twin goals of promoting LGBT health/wellness and human rights. The Center provides targeted programs and services to the full diversity of the San Diego LGBT community, including men, women, youth, seniors, transgender and non-binary individuals, families, LGBT Latin@ community members and their families, and those living with HIV. Last year, The Center provided more than 82,000 direct service visits to San Diego community members, and through its events, activities and advocacy, touched the lives of thousands more.

A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD CO-CHAIRS

Every year at The San Diego LGBT Community Center has its milestones and challenges –

supporting, serving and advocating for our community at the highest levels. This year was a year of significant leadership change for The Center, as Dr. Delores A. Jacobs – our dedicated and respected chief executive officer for the past 17 years – stepped down at the end of June.

But true to form, Delores worked tirelessly with the board to ensure a thoughtful and transparent transition. The extensive effort included community engagement with our diverse Center stakeholders and a national executive search. And at the end of that rigorous process, we were thrilled to announce that we found our next leader very close to home – our very own Caroline (Cara) Dessert, Esq.

Cara had previously served as The Center's Chief Development and Community Engagement Officer. She and Delores helped us successfully secure a \$2 million match opportunity and an additional \$1.6 million gift that enabled The Center to pay off its mortgage at our Centre Street location. Prior to that, Cara was the executive director of Immigration Equality, a national organization focused on LGBT immigrant rights. Many of us came to know Cara during her time as the lead field organizer for our local efforts to defeat Proposition 8. Her enthusiasm, focus and dedication have always been clear, perhaps never more so than in the last six months as she's made the transition into The Center's chief executive officer.

Our Center – and our community – are fortunate to have had such incredible leaders like Delores and Cara to help us achieve great things this past year. You'll read more about those in this report, but we can't go without highlighting two of the most significant accomplishments.

In April of this year, we opened San Diego's first LGBT senior housing community in partnership with Community Housing Works, providing affordable and affirming housing for those who came before us and helped pave the path toward equality. Then, in November, we saw the power of The Center's advocacy efforts materialize as we helped mobilize Equality Voters to create change at the ballot box.

We have much to look forward to in 2019, and thank you for your continued and vital support of The San Diego LGBT Community Center.

Today, The Center continues to embody the values set forth since our founding – to provide support for our community's most vulnerable; to create a place for our LGBT community to come together, to belong; and to fight for our basic human rights and dignity.

Last year, The Center provided 82,000 service visits to our community, and thousands more came through our doors to find community. We remain committed to opening those doors even wider for more people in our beautifully diverse community.

This next chapter of The Center is an exciting one, but also a challenging one. We will continue to fight for those who are most marginalized – our transgender community, immigrants, and those at highest risk for HIV. As one of the largest and most vibrant LGBT community centers in the country – thanks to incredible and ongoing community support – we will do even more to ensure that The Center's life-changing, and sometimes life-saving, services are available and accessible to everyone who needs them.

Last year, in partnership with Community Housing Works, we were thrilled to open San Diego's first LGBT senior affordable housing community, not just to provide housing for our elders, but also to honor and thank them for their contributions to our community. In 2019, we opened our new South Bay Youth Center to better serve our LGBTQ and non-binary youth, youth living with HIV, and their families and allies.

The Center continues to be a source of hope, and direct assistance, to our LGBTQ asylum seekers. We will continue to support our transgender community members – young and old – with programs and services they want and need. We will continue the work on all fronts to #BeTheGeneration to end HIV. And we will strive to change the landscape where 40% of homeless youth are LGBTQ, where LGBT people of color continue to experience significant health disparities and where too many of our seniors still experience isolation and loneliness.

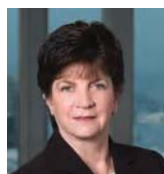

In 1971 our world was a very different place. Being “out” simply wasn’t an option for many. Just being a member of the LGBT community could be dangerous, and there was no place to turn for help.

We are proud of the history of The Center’s service. Originally just an answering machine in a borrowed closet that served as a lifeline for those looking for compassionate connection, it is now one of the largest and most vibrant LGBT Community Centers in the nation, providing our community with more than 82,000 direct service visits each year.

1971-1972

The initial 1971-1972 Planning Committee for what would become The Center included Patricia Byers, Thom Carey, Patricia Cluchey, Peggy Heathers, Jess Jessop, Clint Johnson, Bernie Michels, George Murphy, Jerry Peterson, Gary Rees, John Senter, Jerry White, John Eberly, Gary Gulley and Cynthia Lawrence. The Chair of the Planning Committee was Bernie Michels



1973 The Center for Social Services was incorporated as a 501c3



1980 The Center for Social Services became the Lesbian and Gay Men’s Community Center

1981

Diagnosis of the first case of HIV disease in San Diego County

1998

The Behavioral Health Services RVTIP program received credentialing, and became one of the first same-sex domestic violence programs in the nation



1999

The Lesbian and Gay Men’s Community Center moved from Normal Street to Centre Street and began plans for renovations

2000

The Hillcrest Youth Center opened its doors and became a critical resource for LGBTQ youth in San Diego



2001

Dr. Delores A. Jacobs named interim executive director June 2001 and is selected as executive director in January 2002. Jacobs serves a historic, 17-year tenure as the longest serving chief executive, and retiring on June 30, 2018



2001

The David Bohnett Cyber Center opened

2001

The Public Policy department was established after the No on Prop. 22 campaign



2002

The Lesbian and Gay Men’s Center was renamed the San Diego Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender Community Center

2003

The Women's Resource Center was established, providing LBT women and their allies access to important health and social resources and referrals

2003

AIDS Walk & Run San Diego returned to The Center as a Center program



2003 Senior Services and 50 and Better Together were established, providing important health, financial and social resources for LGBT seniors

2004

The Community Leadership Council was established, bringing together more than 40 LGBT and allied community organizations each month to address the needs of the community



2004

Latin@ Services was established, providing culturally-affirming drop-in space, support groups and social programs for LGBT Latin@s and their families



2004

The Wall of Honor was established, honoring community members and allies who have had a significant positive impact on the San Diego LGBT community



2006

Sunburst Youth Housing Project opened, providing supportive housing for 23 homeless LGBT and HIV+ youth, ages 18-24

2007

The Center Advocacy Project was established, a nonpartisan 501(c)4, whose mission is to secure equal civil and human rights for the LGBT and allied communities through public education and issue advocacy



2007

Family programming was re-established at The Center, providing programs and services for LGBT-headed families and those considering parenthood



2008

The Equality Voters program was established to encourage community-wide voter registration and full, non-partisan, participation in elections

2009

Nicole Murray Ramirez, Robert Gleason, Dr. Delores Jacobs, The San Diego LGBT Community Center, and a broad coalition of civic and business leaders established the first Harvey Milk Diversity Breakfast. Since then it has grown to become one of the largest, most diverse events of its kind, bringing together more than 1,000 San Diegans annually

2010

Engage San Diego was established, forming a nonprofit network of local civil rights, social justice, health and environmental organizations focused on nonpartisan civic engagement



2010

The Center became a monthly distribution site for the San Diego Food Bank

2011

Senior Housing Needs Assessment completed



2012

The Young Professionals Council was established in **2009** to develop and empower young LGBT professionals and their allies. As part of that effort, in **2012** the YPC Academy was established to help prepare young leaders to further equality through board service for a variety of agencies, not-for-profit organizations and government commissions

2012 The Benjamin F. Dillingham, III and Bridget Wilson LGBT Veterans Wall of Honor, first envisioned by Nicole Murray-Ramirez, was established in 2012 to honor and celebrate LGBT veterans who have served

2012 The Center began working with Community Housing Works to establish an LGBT-welcoming affordable senior housing project in San Diego



2013

Project TRANS was established to provide services designed specifically for San Diego's transgender, nonbinary, and genderfluid community



2014

The #BeTheGeneration campaign launched, with the goal of ending new cases of HIV within a decade



2016 The #BeTheGeneration TRANS campaign launched



2016 The LGBT-welcoming affordable senior housing project broke ground

2017

The Center's Youth Services opened the South Bay Clubhouse, a weekly drop-in space for LGBTQ youth in Chula Vista

2017

At The Center's 45th Anniversary Gala, a \$2 million dollar matching campaign opportunity was announced



2017

Dr. Delores Jacobs announced her intended retirement from The Center. Through more than 200 interviews and focus groups, feedback was solicited regarding characteristics sought in the new Center chief executive

2018 The LGBT-welcoming affordable senior housing project opens



2018 The Center reaches \$2 million goal with unprecedented community support, matching donors Ron Bowman, with his husband Stan Zukowsky announce a second gift of \$1.65 million to pay off mortgage for the Centre Street building in spring of 2018



2018 The Center's Board of Directors host a Fall Fundraiser welcoming new CEO, Caroline (Cara) Dessert, Esq. and announcing the new South Bay Youth Center opening in 2019

Center Board announces selection of Caroline (Cara) Dessert, Esq. as the next Center Chief Executive Officer effective July 1, 2018



#BETHEGENERATION STORIES

#BeTheGeneration is our comprehensive campaign that seeks to end new cases of HIV by 2024 through a combination of education, outreach, and services. #BeTheGeneration encompasses all of The Center's programs, and ensures that stigma and barriers to testing are broken down (fight) so that individuals know their status (test), and can make informed choices on how to remain HIV negative (protect), or take care of their health should they be diagnosed with HIV (treat).

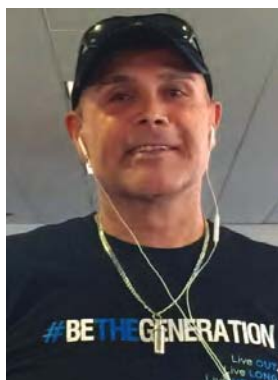
Along with the OraQuick HIV Rapid Antibody test, The Center also offers the UCSD Early Test, Monday through Friday from 9am to 8pm (last appointment at 7pm), and Saturday from 10am to 3pm. The Early Test is a specialized viral load test that can detect acute (very early stage) HIV infection as soon as one week after potential exposure. Hepatitis C Rapid Antibody testing is also available every day. **For more information, call 619.692.2077 x101 or visit events.thecentersd.org/BTG.**

In 2018, we had 18 people with a preliminary positive result. 16 of those 18 (89%) were linked to care. As of today, 100% of those linked to care are still in care.

"I found out I was HIV-positive over 14-years ago, and at first, wasn't sure what to do. I was lucky though to get into medical care and have made sure to visit my doctor every 3 months, and adhere to my medication. Friday, May 17, 2019

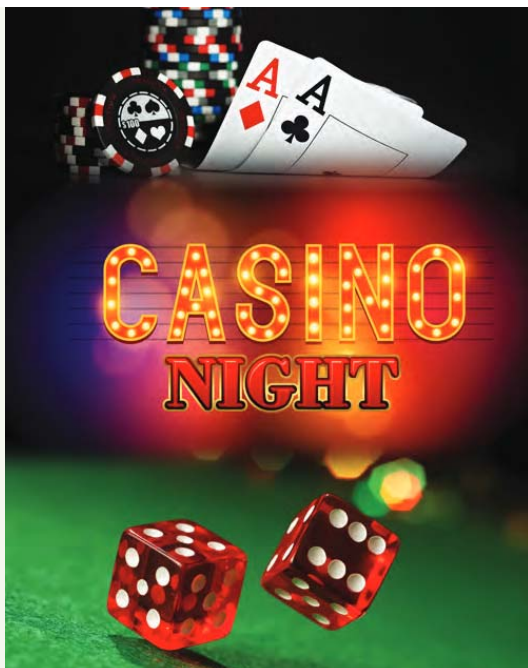

South Bay Youth Center

In an effort to expand our reach, The Center will be adding a new service location opening February 2019 in

South Bay located at 1180 3rd Avenue, Suite C1, Chula Vista, CA 91911. The Center's South Bay Youth Center in Chula Vista will provide similar programming to The Center's Hillcrest Youth Center, offering a drop-in and recreational center for LGBTQ and non-binary youth, youth living with HIV, and their families and allies.

Established in 2019 to meet the increased demand for services for LGBTQ+ youth, families, and their allies to increase access to vital support and programs, the SBYC will offer gender identity groups, arts programs, social activities, tutoring and discussion groups. A therapist will also be available on site.

The South Bay Youth Center will be open three days a week from 3-7pm – on Wednesdays for youth ages 18-24, on Thursdays for 14-18 year olds and Fridays for those ages 10-13. In addition, the Youth Center will be open on Monday evenings for Mi Familia, a support group for parents of LGBTQ youth.
